



## Internet safety

A study carried out on sample of pupils in years 7-9 within the school highlighted that 50% of respondents use the internet every day, some of those pupils for up to 4 hrs a day.

Gaming, chat rooms and social networking seemed to be what the pupils were mostly involved in.

61% of children surveyed had online contacts that they had never met and 24% said that they had been to meet a contact they had only ever met online.

In school we have increased our education on Internet safety, but we realise that some education also takes place at home.
